## Small Class Sizes and Safe and Secure



Located in the center of Detroit Lakes across from the hospital, we have been a vibrant part of the community

since 1916. Serving culturally diverse students from preschool through grade eight, HRS offers small classes in which students can grow spiritually, academically and socially in a Catholic environment. A nurturing, experienced, and highly talented professional faculty and staff strive to create an atmosphere in which students can develop their unique and individual talents and strengths.

## Preschool Program

Our Preschool program is two morning or afternoon sessions on Tuesday and Thursday and a full day session on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and is open to children as young as three years old.

The curriculum is grounded in the Catholic faith and focuses on self expression of the world around them. Students will develop their large and small motor skills, be introduced to music, taught concepts related to numbers and letters and socialize in a school setting.



## Tuition, Fundraising and Scholarships

Parents with children enrolled at Holy Rosary Catholic School are required to pay tuition toward the cost of their child's/ children's education. Tuition scholarships are available to those who apply. Each family is asked to help with fundraising to keep tuition rates low.

Graduates of Holy Rosary School are eligible for a two year Paul and Winifred Stary Scholarship for college.



## Religion

A deep understanding of our faith is the primary goal of Holy Rosary School. The curriculum at each grade level supports liturgical and moral formation, fostering a desire to follow Jesus Christ.

## Mathematics

The guidelines of the Diocese of Crookston as well as the Minnesota State Standards are followed. Topics covered throughout a school career include number concepts, problem solving, algebra, geometry, measurement, estimation, mental math, and technology.

## Music, Band, Art, Physical Education and Resource Center

## Language Arts

Integrated language arts includes reading, phonics, grammar, writing and spelling in primary grades. Grades six through eight study literature, writing, spelling and grammar.

## Computers and iPads

All students in grades kindergarten through eighth receive weekly technology instruction. The well-equipped lab provides opportunities to develop skills in word processing, multimedia presentation, Internet research skills, spreadsheet and database. Integration of technology with the various curriculum areas is ongoing.

## Social Studies

Students begin their studies in this subject with the family and communities. Topics include ancient history, Minnesota, American history and geography skills.

## Science

All students learn through hands-on science at all levels. Topics at the upper levels include earth, life and physical science. Holy Rosary is a Groundwater Guardian Community.

## Service

Each grade has annual service projects, reaching out to those in our community and beyond. Past projects have included writing to those incarcerated, collecting supplies for other countries, donating food to the local food pantry, helping sandbag during the Fargo flooding, and visiting the local nursing homes.
