

Percy & Winifred Stary Family Scholarship

Guidelines

- 1) The student must have attended at least grade 6 – 8; and have graduated from Holy Rosary Catholic School.
- 2) The student must have maintained a B average or better for the last years of high school.
- 3) The student must have completed the first year of a four year or two year college and maintained a 'B' average or better. A 'B' average or better must be maintained to be eligible for a successive scholarship. No individual student will be awarded the scholarship for more than two years.
- 4) The student must be pursuing a technical, science or medical degree or certificate. Qualifying fields of study would include but not necessarily be limited to engineering, physician, nurse, pharmacists, chemist, computer science or programming, math/science educator, draughtsman, surveyor, etc.
- 5) Those attending a four year college will be eligible for a maximum scholarship considered being an amount equal to one half of the prevailing cost of resident housing and tuition at Minnesota State University-Moorhead.

Those attending a two year college shall be eligible for a full scholarship considered to be an amount on half the full value of a scholarship for a four year student.

The above amounts only suggest the nominal size of scholarship awards preferred by the donor. The amount of scholarship awarded may actually be reduced due to other considerations including coursework load, family financial situation, endowment income, etc.

- 6) The total household income and family situations of the eligible student and parents will be considered in determining awards.
- 7) Applications shall be available January. Candidates are encourage to apply while in their senior year of high school, although later applications will be honored.

- 8) Deadline date for final receipt of application is June 1.
- 9) Scholarship funds shall be awarded August and funds disbursed by September.
