#### Hot Lunch for students and adults (optional)

- Student Meal: \$3 each, \$60—20 meals, \$498—166 meals for the year
  - Adult Meals: \$3.80 each
  - Extra milk: 25 cents each

#### During snack time, milk or juice is available (optional)

- Students in grades 1—8: \$50/year. Half year/\$25, with second half due Jan. 15th.
- Kindergarten class receives milk at snack time which is paid through the Minnesota Kindergarten Nutrition Program.
  - Preschool brings their own snacks as designated by their teacher.

## Holy Rosary School Fund Raising and Service Commitment

Families are asked to help with fundraising to keep tuition rates low and to fund our school.

Families are asked to volunteer with service projects in our school community.

Working together as a school family we can make a difference.

**The following is the specified hours and raffle tickets required of each school family.**

Note: If you have a child in preschool besides a child (ren) in K—8, you are asked to complete extra hours and sell extra raffle tickets.

- **Family of students in Kindergarten— 8th Grade**

1. Five (5) hours of service is required for revenue generating hours. \$50 per hour
2. Five (5) hours of service is required for school activities (non-fundraising). \$50 per hour
3. Sell or purchase five (5) Raffle Calendar Tickets at \$25 each
4. Sell 20 Catholic Schools Raffle Tickets at \$5 each

- **Family of Full Day Preschool**

1. Three (3) hours of service is required for revenue generating hours. \$50 per hour
2. Three (3) hours of service is required for school activities (non-fundraising). \$50 per hour
3. Sell or purchase three (3) Raffle Calendar Tickets at \$25 each
4. Sell 10 Catholic Schools Raffle Tickets at \$5 each

- **Family of Half Day Preschool**

1. One (1) hour of service is required for revenue generating hours. \$50 per hour
2. One (1) hour of service is required for school activities (non-fundraising). \$50 per hour
3. Sell or purchase one (1) Raffle Calendar Ticket at \$25 each
4. Sell five (5) Catholic Schools Raffle Tickets at \$5 each

### **Service for School Activities—Volunteering**

1. \_\_\_ School Advisory Council Member. Assist the Superintendent/Pastor and Principal govern the school and make or set school policies.
2. \_\_\_ PTO Board Member (Parent-Teacher Organization): Assist principal with parent-teacher related activities.
3. \_\_\_ Playground and/or Lunchroom volunteer. Help supervise students during recess or lunchroom. One or more days per week, your choice! Lunchroom: 11:10 a.m. - 12 noon, and/or Playground: 11:30 a.m. - 12:25 p.m.

8. \_\_\_\_ Christmas Musical: This performance has many areas of production needing volunteers to assist with costumes, scenery, and refreshments.
9. \_\_\_\_ Track and Field Day. In May, grades K—8 enjoy a fun day at the Detroit Lakes High School Track and Field. Help is needed with various events and sitting with students in the bleachers.

### **Fundraising—Revenue Generating Service Hours**

1. \_\_\_\_ **PTO Scholastic Book Fair** which is held in the fall and spring. Volunteers are needed to help set up, sell and put away. Funds raised are for the school library.
2. \_\_\_\_ **Parish Festival** which is held in August. Help is needed for set-up, clean-up, chairing or helping at booths.
3. \_\_\_\_ **Pie Sale** which is held the week before Thanksgiving. Parents, family and friends get together for a 3-day pie baking adventure. Home-made apple and pumpkin pies are made and sold throughout the community. Lots of help is needed and there are many jobs to do.
4. \_\_\_\_ **Minnesota Marathon for Nonpublic Education**: Students, parents, teachers, and friends will seek pledges and walk, bike, roller blade or jog 11 miles around Big and Little Detroit Lake. Help is needed on the day of the Marathon in various areas. Pledges do not count towards your commitment. Only actual hours worked/volunteered: example: help with rest stops, search and patrol, luncheon, registration and or other help needed.
5. \_\_\_\_ **Spring Interlude Dinner, Dance, and Auction Event**: This is the biggest fund raiser of the year for our school. It is held in the spring. Lots of help is needed with planning, auctions, setting up, and cleaning up.

### **Raffles**

1. \_\_\_\_ **Raffle Calendar**: These \$25 Raffle Calendars/tickets are sold November—May. The drawings are June 1—November 30. Help is needed to sell 1,000 raffle calendars to make \$25,000 with a payout of \$10,000. Daily winners receive cash depending on the day: \$25, \$75, \$250 and \$500! If a winner wins once their name always goes back in the drawing for the next day.
2. \_\_\_\_ **Catholic Schools Raffle sponsored by Catholic United Financial**: Our goal is \$15,000 and all money stays at our school. These \$5 raffle tickets are sold in January and February with the big drawing in March. This raffle is sold to Catholic Schools in the tri state area and you can win up to \$40,000 in prizes. *Note: We will have cash drawings for every student who sells 20 raffle tickets each.
