**The Percy & Winifred Stary Family Scholarship
for Science, Engineering or Mathematics Fields of Study**

- 1) The student must have attended grade 6 – 8 and have graduated from Holy Rosary Catholic School. The student must have maintained a B average or better for the last years of high school.
- 2) The student must have completed the first year of a four year or two year college and maintained a 'B' average or better. A 'B' average or better must be maintained to be eligible for a successive scholarship. No individual student will be awarded the scholarship for more than two years and must be applied for with in two consecutive years. (four year college)
- 3) Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree/major if attending a four year college, or a specific certificate if attending a two year college.

The selection of a scholarship recipient will favor eligible candidates who are pursuing degrees/certificates that embrace the science, technical, engineering or mathematics fields of study, as opposed to the arts, business, social or life sciences fields of study.

- 4) The scholarship committee *may* choose up to three eligible scholarship recipients each year of which the maximum award amount will be determined based on the following:
 - a. **Those attending a four year college will be eligible for a maximum scholarship considered being an amount equal to one half of the prevailing cost of resident housing and tuition at Minnesota State University-Moorhead.**
 - b. **Those attending a two year college shall be eligible for a full scholarship considered to be an amount on half the full value of a scholarship for a four year student.**
- 5) The total household income and family situations of the eligible student and parents will be considered in determining awards.
- 6) Applications shall be available in January.
- 7) Deadline date for final receipt of application, official transcripts, and income information is June 1. Scholarship funds shall be dispersed to the student's college in July-August.
