#### **Bad Weather Policy**

<u>All</u> children are expected to go outside for recess. Your child can stay *inside* only if the school is provided with a **doctor's excuse**. In colder weather the time is shortened and in extreme cold or wet weather noon recess is cancelled and children stay inside. When the temperature/wind chill reaches 10 below zero all students may be required to stay inside.

When school is *cancelled or late due* to bad weather, you will receive a phone call, text, and email from the *SchoolMessenger*" *Parent Contact System*. Also, please listen to KDLM or KRCQ radio stations, or WDAY TV for school cancellations. If Detroit Lakes Public Schools are cancelled, Holy Rosary School and Preschool are also cancelled, as we bus together. If school is two hours late on Tues. or Thurs. morning preschool is cancelled.
