Middle School

Our rescheduled, 2019 Middle School Twin Cities Field Trip was a great success. In addition to much improved weather, we were able to make three stops: Historic Fort Snelling, the Mall of America Aquarium, and the Minnesota History Museum, all in one day! At Fort Snelling, we learned where the waters meet at the confluence of the Minnesota and Mississippi Rivers. Not only was this high ground for the Fort's protection, it was as the sacred land of the Dakota people called "Bdote". At the Fort, we also got to take part in a number of outdoor activities including learning how to march in traditional military order, watching a firearms demonstration, and learning how to do laundry in a giant iron pot which took 75 buckets of river water to fill in the mid-1800's.

At the aquarium, we saw plenty of sharks swimming overhead and also got a behind the scenes tour where we visited the kitchen where they prepared the many different types of fish and vegetables for the various types of fish they house! We wrapped up the day at the Minnesota History Museum where we saw a working mining display, an authentic fur trading post and a display on Minnesota's Greatest Generation including a variety of military uniforms, a soda shop and a WWII airplane complete with a paratrooper movie/demonstration that had the kids jumping!
