A Holy Rosary education is an investment in your child's future!

#### Registration Timeline for the 2023-2024 School Year

- Thursday, February 2, 2023 Registration materials are sent home for current students.
- <u>Friday, February 3 Friday, February 17</u> Registration is open for current students.
- <u>Friday, February 17</u> Registration is due for current students by 5:00 p.m. Materials not turned in by this date will result in an open spot for a new family.
- Monday, February 20 Registration opens for parish families.
- Monday, February 27 Registration opens for others on a first come, first served basis, as space is available. Appointments for tours can be made and will be ongoing through the summer.

#### **Admissions:**

Holy Rosary School welcomes those families who would like to provide their children with a Catholic education. It is our intent to accept as many students as is feasible. A child will be enrolled if we believe we can meet his/her educational needs. Prior to enrollment, families must disclose if there is an academic concern or an established 504 or IEP plan in place at a previous school, or a physical or mental diagnosed impairment from an outside agency. Students who have been expelled, suspended, or are on probation from another school may be admitted upon careful review of the individual case. If there are questions or concerns about the ability of Holy Rosary School to meet the needs of any student, additional information and or a trial period may be established. Holy Rosary School reserves the right to suggest alternate placement, to deny admittance, or expel a student admitted during a trial period.

Determinations for Kindergarten Prep and Kindergarten enrollment, as well as Gr. 1-8 students who are on the waitlist, will be based on the following admission criteria.

#### Admission Criteria:

- 1. Siblings of Holy Rosary Parish families already enrolled in our school.
- 2. Siblings of non-Holy Rosary Parish families already enrolled in our school.
- 3. Holy Rosary parishioners not already enrolled.
- 4. Non-Holy Rosary parishioners not already enrolled.

After registration if we find that any grade level has filled with new parish families, we will have an enrollment lottery. This means that if we receive more applications than we have openings, we choose students through a lottery system. This would apply to Kindergarten Prep and Kindergarten classes. Registration in Kindergarten Prep does not guarantee a spot in Kindergarten. Students who have applied but aren't chosen through the lottery system will be placed on a waiting list.

## 2023-2024 Registration Information

#### **Classroom Size Guidelines:**

We are a parish school, opening our doors to all parishioners who wish to have their children here and to non-parishioners as there is room. Each year, classroom sizes will be evaluated upon room availability, financial considerations, class population and characteristics, and overall school needs. Final decisions pertaining to the size of a class will be determined by the administration.

#### Waitlist:

The recommended student enrollment is set by the Superintendent, Principal, and the School Advisory Council. The school does its best to follow this recommended capacity, however, extenuating factors may influence the decision of the superintendent and principal when determining classroom sizes. Priority on the waitlist will be determined by the admission criteria described above.

#### **Tuition:**

Holy Rosary School must charge tuition to operate the school, maintain programs, and modestly compensate the staff. Our tuition is based upon the cost to educate a child and is established annually. After reviewing the past budget and receiving input from the School Council and the Parish Finance Council, the administrative team decides upon tuition. Parents/Guardians are notified of the tuition for the upcoming year. As part of the registration process, Parents/Guardians are required to sign a registration agreement, which is expected to be honored. A non-refundable registration fee is required for registration.

#### **Instructions for Enrolling New Students:**

- 1. Register with FACTS, our online tuition payment system: https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4114J
  - A \$25 registration fee will be applied to your account if you are registered by May 31, 2023; registrations received after May 31, 2023, are charged a \$50 fee.
  - To apply for financial aid, click on the "FACTS Financial Aid" link and follow the instructions. Applications must be submitted by June 1, 2023.
  - K-8 families who pay their tuition in full by September 1, 2023, will receive a 2% discount.
- Visit our school website, <u>www.holyrosarycs.org</u>, to obtain registration materials. Click on "Current Families" and then "New Families" for access to printable registration forms. Forms can also be obtained at the school office.

### **Instructions for Reenrolling Existing Students:**

- 1. Complete the "Registration Agreement Form" and return it to the school office.
- 2. In May, your FACTS tuition payment plan will be automatically "rolled over" to the next year and a registration fee of \$25 will be applied. Registration received after May 31 will result in a \$50 fee. If you wish to make changes to your payment plan, please contact Principal Cathy Larson. To apply for Financial Aid, click on the "FACTS Financial Aid" link and follow instructions. This is to be done annually, by June 1, even if you have applied in the past.

At Holy Rosary School, we are continually looking into the future to ensure that our Catholic values and excellence in education are available for generations to come. Like many parish schools, the tuition we charge does not cover the actual cost of educating our students.

Currently, the actual cost of educating one student at Holy Rosary is \$6,770 per year, while the actual spending per student in Minnesota public schools is \$13,302. Therefore, the fundraising activities that Holy Rosary School promotes are necessary to make up the difference and keep the parish subsidy under 30% of the total budget.



Your Time Really Pays Off

Volunteering at Holy Rosary School pays off in more ways than one! As a trial program for 2023-2024, when you double your volunteer hours, you'll earn \$25 per hour for every extra hour you volunteer. Those extra dollars can be used toward your fundraising goal! What does this look like? If you have two children enrolled and need to put in 20 volunteer hours (10 hours per child x 2), you can work 30 hours and earn \$250!

## 50/50 FUNDRAISING

Exceed Your Goal and Earn Money Toward Tuition!


Another new concept we're trying in 2023-2024 is 50/50 Fundraising. This program will allow dollars raised <u>over and above</u> a family's fundraising goal to be split, with 50% going to Holy Rosary School and 50% going directly to the family's tuition account!

How does it work? If your fundraising goal for two children is \$1375 and you earn \$1575, \$100 will go to the school and \$100 will go into your tuition account!
