






It's Time!

Registration for the 2023-2024 school year will open on Thursday, February 2 to families currently enrolled at Holy Rosary School. Registration will open for Parish families not currently enrolled beginning Monday, February 20. Registration opens to the public on Monday, February 27.





REMINDER: There will be NO afterschool bus service Wednesday, February 1 for Holy Rosary School

Weather Policy: All children are expected to go outside for noon recess. Your child can stay inside only if the school is provided with a doctor's excuse. In colder weather the time is shortened and in extreme cold or wet weather noon recess is cancelled and children stay inside. When the temperature/wind chill -10 below zero all students may be required to stay inside. Also, in the event that school is cancelled due to bad weather, you will receive a phone call, text, and email from the Holy Rosary "School Messenger" Parent Contact System. Also, please listen to KDLM or KRCQ radio stations, or KVLY or WDAY TV. If Detroit Lakes Public Schools are cancelled, Holy Rosary School is also cancelled, as we bus together.


