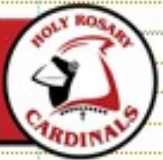

Please **RSVP to the Parish Office @ 847-1393 by February 22.** The Knights will transport the youth from the mountain to Holy Rosary after tubing.



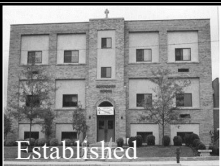
Artist Q&A Session

Weather Policy: All children are expected to go outside for noon recess. Your child can stay *inside* only if the school is provided with a **doctor's excuse**. In colder weather the time is shortened and in extreme cold or wet weather noon recess is cancelled and children stay inside. When the temperature/wind chill reaches -10 below zero all students may be required to stay inside. **Also, in the event that school is cancelled due to bad weather, you will receive a phone call, text, and email from the Holy Rosary "School Messenger" Parent Contact System.** Also, please listen to KDLM or KRCQ radio stations, or KVLV or WDAY TV. **If Detroit Lakes Public Schools are cancelled, Holy Rosary School is also cancelled, as we bus together.**
