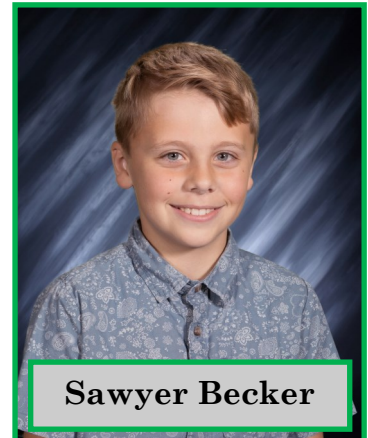
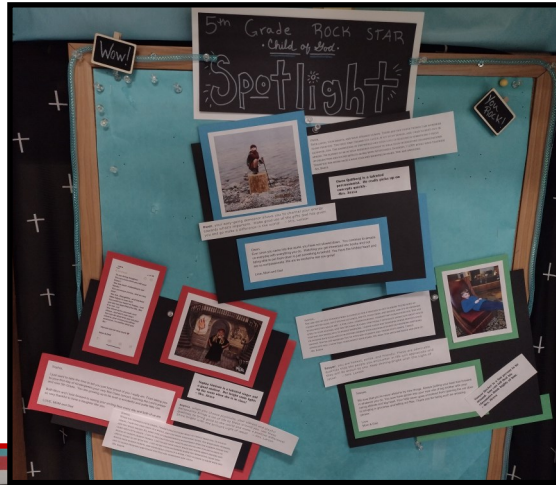


5th Grade Child of God Spotlight!

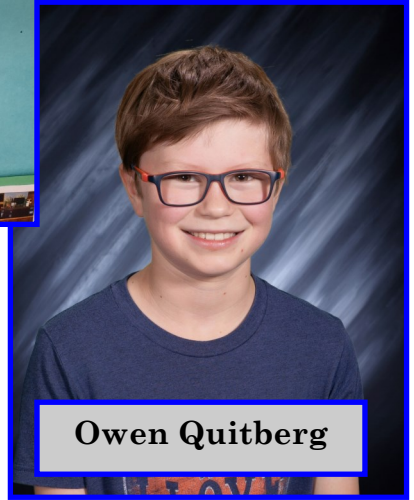
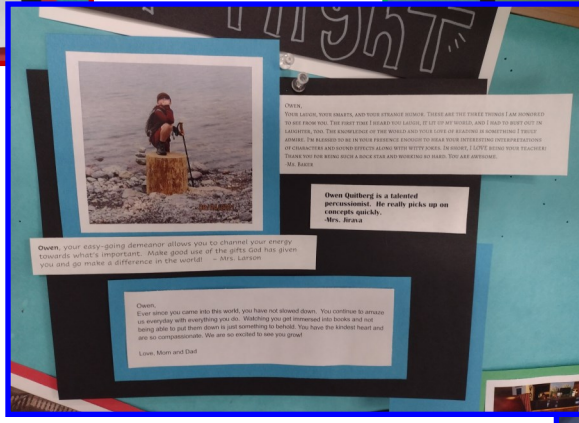
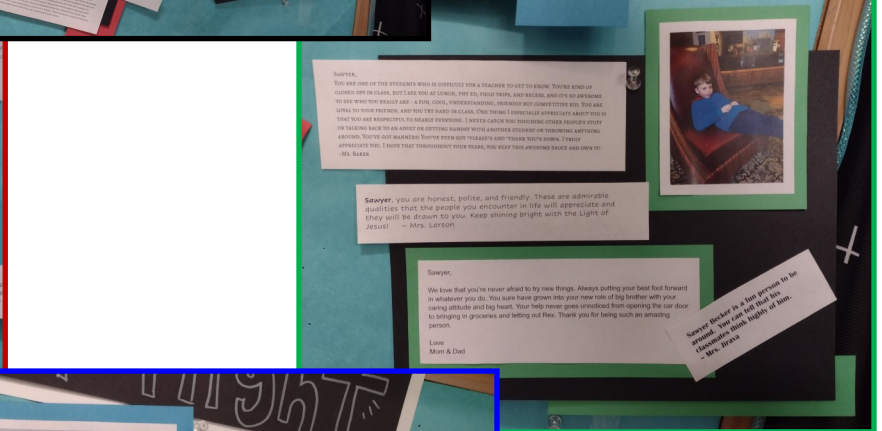
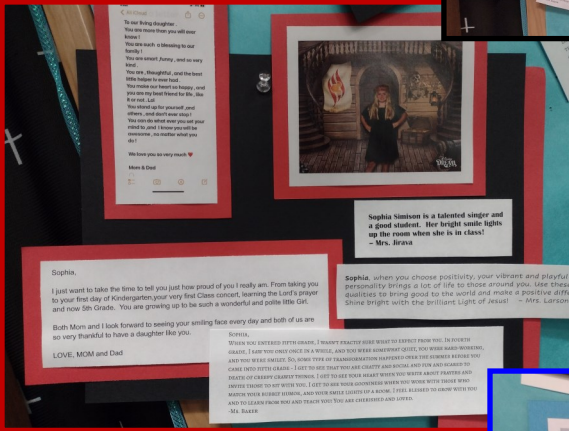
